City Hospital, Jefferson Health Care Foundation Board Elects Officers

MARTINSBURG, W.Va. - The newly expanded board of directors for the City Hospital Foundation and Jefferson Health Care Foundations recently elected officers for 2010.

In January 2005, both foundations became affiliates of WVUH-East, the area's regional health system which includes City Hospital and Jefferson Memorial Hospital. Although they share a common governing board, the foundations remain separate not-for-profit organizations.
